DIG IN

- 3. Read John 2:23-25. What does Jesus "know" about every human that makes him unwilling to fully entrust himself to them? What specifically is it about humans that needs to be fixed?
- 4. Read John 3:1-2. What did Nicodemus and the other Pharisees know about Jesus? Why did they seek to destroy him instead of honor him?
- 5. In John 3:3-12, Jesus exposes Nicodemus' "human thinking" by sharing God's view. Why was this religious leader so confused about what Jesus was saying?
- 6. Just before he declares the words of John 3:16, Jesus talks about Moses' lifting a serpent up on a pole as a way of foreshadowing his own death on the cross. What is Jesus saying here?

DIGGING DEEPER (EXTRA CREDIT!)

- 7. What is the significance of Nicodemus' coming by night and in secret? Do you think that Nicodemus cared too much about his reputation to become a disciple?
- 8. Would you consider yourself to be "born again"? What does that phrase mean to you?
- 9. Nicodemus gave Jesus a "king's burial" in John 19:38-42. With this in mind, do you think he went on to live as a Christian, or did he remain a member of the Sanhedrin as it opposed and persecuted the followers of Jesus?
